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Mid-Year Population

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Births, deaths and migration are the main factors that affect the population change of a country. As births, deaths and migrations are a continuous process, the population of a country or any territory is constantly changing over time. Every country conducts a census to calculate the population at any given moment. Thus, the last population and housing census in Sri Lanka was conducted in 2012 and the next census is planned to be conducted in 2024. Population is estimated annually on the basis of administrative data on births, deaths and migration in the country during the inter-census period. This estimate is based on July 1 and is called the Mid-Year population. The estimate for a respective year is calculated by adding the difference between registered births and deaths from July 1st of the previous year to June 30th of the respective year (natural increase = number of births - number of deaths) and net migration (net migration = number of people entering the country - number of people leaving the country), to the midyear population count of the previous year.

According to Table 1, during period July 2012 - June 2013 there were 352,450 registered births and from the that period to July 2013 - June 2014 period, number of registered births has been increased from 352,450 to 361,800. Since then the number of registered births has gradually decreased every year and during the period of July 2022 to June 2023, number of registered births was 268,920.

Furthermore, the number of registered deaths from July 2012 to June 2013 was 125,626 and by the period of July 2022 to June 2023, there has been a gradual growth to 190,600.

According to the data from Department of Immigration and Emigration, during the periods from July 2015 to June 2018 and July 2020 to June 2021, inward migration was higher than the outward migration and in rest of the periods; outward migration was higher than the inward migration after the last population census.

Net migration during the July 2021 to June 2022 period was negative 85,572 and it was negative 222,715 during the July 2022 to June 2023 period also.

Thus, the average annual population in the year 2023 has decreased by 144,395 compared to the year 2022, considering births decrease, deaths increase in and the immediate increase in the population that left the country.
